# ***BLAUER ZWEIGELT 2018***

*Red Quality Wine, Burgenland - Austria*

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**T**his Blauer Zweigelt is vinted at our vineyards on the eastern shores of the large, shallow steppe Lake Neusiedl or Neusiedlersee in the heart of Austria's Burgenland province. The vines flourish on long hours of sunshine influenced by the Pannonian climate of hot, dry summers and cold winters, as well as the moderating effects of the large surface area of water from the vast Lake Neusiedl.

## BLAUER ZWEIGELT

Blauer Zweigelt is the most widespread red wine variety in Austria. At the end of last century, when red wine variety began to increase, the Zweigelt represented the biggest share of reds in the vineyards.

It demands little from the soil but, because it is a very fertile grape, requires intensive leaf work and yield regulation.

## VINIFICATION

Machine and hand-picking, more than 10 days maceration, temperature-controlled fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

## TASTING NOTES

Intensive fruit flavors and light cherry notes. This Zweigelt is full-bodied with a smooth and round acidity structure, resulting in a soft, velvety wine. Well integrated and decent tannin structure.

## FOOD SUGGESTIONS

Light meat and poultry, vegetarian dishes.
