White Quality Wine, Styria - Austria

Vinted at our wine estates in Styria, the grapes for the Chardonnay can only be harvested by hand, owing to the steep hillsides. The viticulture in Styria is amongst Europe's finest, with its charming scenery, yet it also includes some of the hardest and most challenging terrain because most of the vineyards are planted on extremely steep inclines.

CHARDONNAY

The internationally widespread variety Chardonnay has a long tradition being cultivated in Styria although it became more important in Austrian vineyards at the end of the last century. Nowadays it represents about 3,5% of Austria's vineyard area.

Chardonnay requires warm vineyard sites with deep soil and good water retention.

VINIFICATION

Hand-picking, temperature-controlled fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

The Chardonnay is a fresh, delicate and flowery wine. Its fragrance is reminiscent of white bread and exotic fruits. The Chardonnay is full-bodied and retains a good degree of pleasant acidity.

Chicken, turkey, barbecues, smoked fish, pastries, warm cheese dishes.
