Vinted at our wine estates in Styria, the grapes for the Gelber Muskateller can only be harvested by hand, owing to the steep hillsides. The viticulture in Styria is amongst Europe's finest, with its charming scenery, yet it also includes some of the hardest and most challenging terrain because most of the vineyards are planted on extremely steep inclines.

GELBER MUSKATELLER

Muskateller is one of the oldest grape varieties which comes from the Mediterranean area. This variety has gained popularity with consumers. Therefore, it has been planted more and more and has achieved increasing market significance in Austria.

Muskateller has little demands on the soil but in the vineyard, it can be difficult and challenging because of a sensitive flowering phase. It needs warm and airy sites.

VINIFICATION

Hand-picking, ca. 6 hours maceration, temperature-controlled fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

This fragrant Muskateller is defined by aromas from the elderflower. A soft entry leads to a rounded, medium-bodied palate with lush acidity. Long lasting finish.

Aperitif, appetizers, light fish and meat dishes, Asian food.
