WEISSBURGUNDER – PINOT BLANC 2019

White Quality Wine, Styria - Austria

Vinted at our wine estates in Styria, the grapes for the Weißburgunder can only be harvested by hand, owing to the steep hillsides. The viticulture in Styria is amongst Europe's finest, with its charming scenery, yet it also includes some of the hardest and most challenging terrain because most of the vineyards are planted on extremely steep inclines.

WEISSBURGUNDER – PINOT BLANC

The internationally widespread variety Pinot Blanc is also cultivated in Austria. It represents about 4% of Austria's vineyard area.

It is a very demanding variety regarding soil and site.

VINIFICATION

Hand-picking, temperature-controlled fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

The Weissburgunder is rich in substance with subdued fresh fruit and nutty aromas. A lean entry leads to a racy, moderately light-bodied palate with a clean, neutral finish.
