WELSCHRIESLING 2019

White Quality Wine, Styria - Austria

Vinted at our wine estates in Styria, the grapes for the Welschriesling can only be harvested by hand, owing to the steep hillsides. The viticulture in Styria is amongst Europe's finest, with its charming scenery, yet it also includes some of the hardest and most challenging terrain because most of the vineyards are planted on extremely steep inclines.

WELSCHRIESLING

This traditional Austrian variety is cultivated mainly in southern and southeastern Styria as well as in Burgenland. Welschriesling probably originates from northern Italy where it is known as Riesling Italico. It is a very versatile wine and can cover almost all quality levels, from easy-drinking wines to noble sweet wines.

Welschriesling requires early-warming vineyard sites and does not like dryness.

VINIFICATION

Hand-picking, temperature-controlled fermentation and maturation in stainless-steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Welschriesling is popular because of its refreshing fruitiness and subtle spice. The fruity freshness is defined by the complexity of apples and citrus fruits. The vibrant acidity rounds off this light and juvenile wine.

Aperitif, starters, light meat, pasta, fish, cold dishes.
